Dear Parents,

As we adjust to the lifting of Covid restrictions in our College, we would like to inform you of a few updates to ensure our pupils engage fully in school life, while being mindful of their personal responsibility around COVID.

Uniform

Pupils are expected to wear full uniform on all days of school. As we have access to the PE Hall and changing rooms, pupils will change into their PE clothes at PE time only. At all other times pupils will be required to wear the full school uniform. The school uniform is as follows: School Jumper, Navy School trousers/skirt, Striped College shirt and appropriate black footwear. A crested half zip can be worn as an additional outer garment for warmth.

Attendance

In order for a pupil to maximise their learning potential it is really important that they attend and be punctual. Any absence must be explained by a phone call/email to the main office 023-8833877 or office@clonakiltycc.ie. Alternatively, a signed and dated note by parent/guardians can be written into the Student Journal. The note is to be presented to the Year Head prior to absence where possible – if not immediately upon return.

Parents/Guardians are asked to provide a phone call to main office or note in pupil journal in the event of a need for a pupil to leave school during the school day. This note should be signed by the Year Head/Deputy Principal/Principal before leaving who will mark the pupils as an Explained absence on Vsware.
